



Further opening measures for child day-care centres

Further steps have been planned for child day-care centres in Rhineland-Palatinate to open and operate under Corona conditions.

From 8 March 2021, pre-schoolers will be invited back to day-care, as the transition from day-care to primary school is a big step for children and must be well prepared for. In addition, from 8 March 2021, day-care facilities will be open increasingly for those children for whom the existing situation is particularly stressful.

From 15 March 2021, regular operation under Corona conditions is planned, provided that the infection permits. This means that, when all staff members have as much protection as possible through the first vaccination, all children can return to their day-care facility. However, it is also clear that regular operation under Corona conditions cannot be complete normal operation. Under certain circumstances and depending on the situation on site, restrictions may have to be repeatedly imposed on the provision of care – especially during child pick-up and drop-off times.

The request to send the children to the day-care centre only if there is an urgent need for care will remain in place until 15 March 2021. Parents who want to look after their children at home will still have the opportunity to do so. You can claim child sick days as long as the request continues.
