

## Interpretation aid for the 5th Corona Control Ordinance Rhineland Palatinate of 30 April 2020

<b>What?</b>	<b>How?</b>
<b>Collection and delivery services</b>	permitted for all types of goods, including non-commercial suppliers. In facilities which are currently still closed (e.g. restaurants), the person collecting the ordered goods must receive them at a door or window. Entry into rooms by those collecting is not permitted in this case. In open premises (e.g. retail outlets) the regulations concerning these facilities apply.
<b>Car dealerships</b>	Sale and repair permitted
<b>Drive-in cinema</b>	permitted (in compliance with the hygiene requirements, i.e. it is not permitted to get out of the car, no sales of drinks or foods)
<b>Car renting/car sharing</b>	permitted
<b>Carwash facilities</b>	permitted
<b>Bakers</b>	permitted No on-site consumption is permitted.
<b>Bars</b>	closed
<b>Funerals</b>	Funerals are permitted in closest family circles. In addition, clergy or funeral orators and persons required for religious acts may attend funerals. Participation shall be limited to the minimum number of persons required for religious acts. Funeral services in churches are permitted subject to the regulations applicable to church services.
<b>Company canteens</b>	closed, sales for take-away allowed but not consumption on the spot (except canteens in hospitals, rehabilitation clinics and police facilities)
<b>Blood donation appointments</b>	permitted
<b>Cafés</b>	closed; street sales are permitted
<b>Campsites</b>	The operation of campsites for tourist purposes is prohibited. This applies to short-term and long-term campers. The use of these facilities without overnight stays is also prohibited.
<b>Copy shops</b>	permitted
<b>Ice cream parlours</b>	closed; collection, delivery and drop-off services are permitted. street sales permitted, no immediate on-site consumption

<b>Ergo/learning therapies</b>	permitted
<b>Bicycle trade and repair services</b>	permitted
<b>Family holiday resorts</b>	closed
<b>Holiday homes</b>	The provision of services for tourist purposes is prohibited.
<b>Hairdressers</b>	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements
<b>Pedicure</b>	permitted, subject to compliance with hygiene requirements for activities where care is paramount
<b>Golf courses</b>	permitted (in compliance with hygiene requirements and minimum spacing)
<b>Church services</b>	permitted in compliance with the hygiene requirements; passing on objects between the churchgoers among each other is not permitted (e.g. collection bags, hymn books, parts of a prayer rug etc.); communion and Holy Communion are for example permitted in compliance with the hygiene requirements
<b>Church services in drive-in cinema format</b>	permitted
<b>Weddings</b>	Civil marriages are permitted. Church weddings are also permitted subject to the regulations applicable to church services.
<b>Hearing care professionals</b>	permitted
<b>Hotels</b>	Operation for tourist purposes is prohibited.
<b>Dog-walkers</b>	permitted
<b>Dog salons</b>	permitted
<b>Dog training schools</b>	permitted
<b>Snack stalls</b>	permitted, no immediate on-site consumption
<b>Individual outdoor sports</b>	permitted in compliance with the prohibition of contact and minimum spacing; the emphasis is on the individual's own physical activity; leisure activities of a predominantly touristic character are not permitted
<b>Youth hostels</b>	closed
<b>Kiosks</b>	permitted
<b>Cosmetic studios</b>	closed
<b>Agriculture</b>	permitted
<b>HGV wash facilities</b>	permitted
<b>Lottery registration office</b>	permitted in connection with retail outlets (e.g. magazines or stationery etc.)
<b>Malls / outlet centres</b>	permitted (in compliance with the regulations applicable to retail outlets); the obligation to wear a full-face mask exists within the entire mall/outlet centre, regardless of whether it is a closed building complex or a delimited area in the open air.
<b>Massage salons</b>	closed. Medical massages are permitted
<b>Furniture collection services</b>	permitted, since collection service

<b>Music schools</b>	permitted, provided that no more than three persons (including the teacher) take part in the course; singing lessons are not permitted.
<b>Nail studios</b>	closed
<b>Orthopaedic shoemakers, orthopaedic technicians</b>	permitted
<b>Parcel drop-off or collection points</b>	permitted
<b>Personal trainers</b>	Personal training 1 to 1, permitted in a single room in a fitness studio in compliance with the hygiene regulations, in a fitness studio otherwise closed for general sports and training operations
<b>Pawnshops</b>	permitted
<b>Physiotherapy</b>	permitted
<b>Podology</b>	permitted
<b>Travel agents</b>	permitted, in compliance with the rules applicable to retail trade outlets
<b>Sanitary supplies</b>	permitted
<b>Locksmiths</b>	permitted
<b>Ski lifts</b>	closed
<b>Sunbeds</b>	closed
<b>Marinas</b>	permitted
<b>Dance schools</b>	closed
<b>Tattoo studios</b>	closed
<b>Taxi services</b>	permitted
<b>Tennis (popular sport)</b>	permitted outdoors
<b>Retail trade outlets</b>	permitted irrespective of the range of goods and the size of the establishment, in compliance with hygiene requirements. The size of the facility only influences the calculation of the permitted number of persons (e.g.: sales area of 800 sqm: max. 80 persons; sales area of 900 sqm: max. 85 persons (80 + 5))
<b>Weekly markets</b>	permitted
