

Interpretation aid for the 6th Corona Control Ordinance Rhineland Palatinate of 08 May 2020

What?	How?
Collection and delivery services	permitted for all types of goods, including non-commercial suppliers. The service provider must wear a full-face mask if the minimum spacing of 1.5 metres is not observed. The regulations applicable to the respective establishment apply to the collection of goods.
Car dealerships	sale and repair permitted
Drive-in cinema	permitted (in compliance with the hygiene requirements, i.e. it is not permitted to get out of the car, no sales of drinks or foods)
Car renting/car sharing	permitted
Carwash facilities	permitted
Bakers	permitted consumption on site is not permitted if the conditions for the admissibility of catering establishments (in particular the obligation to make reservations and register, catering at tables) cannot be met
Bars	permitted, in compliance with the hygiene requirements applicable to catering establishments (see " Handout for the catering industry - hygiene and safety measures for catering and accommodation", published on the MWVLW website)
Funerals	Funerals are permitted in closest family circles. In addition, clergy or funeral orators and persons required for religious acts may attend funerals. Participation shall be limited to the minimum number of persons required for religious acts. Funeral services in churches are permitted subject to the regulations applicable to church services.
Company canteens	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements
Public and private educational institutions outside general education and vocational schools (e.g. courses in adult education centres) as well as corresponding educational programmes offered by individuals	permitted, provided that at least the "Hygiene Plan Corona for Schools in Rhineland-Palatinate" of 21 April 2020 (published on the Ministry of Education website) in its current valid version is complied with
Blood donation appointments	permitted

Cafés	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements
Campsites	The operation of campsites for tourist purposes is prohibited. The use of caravans, mobile homes and similar accommodation permanently parked on campsites with their own sanitary facilities exclusively for the authorised users is permitted.
Copy shops	permitted
Ice cream parlours	permitted in compliance with hygiene requirements; street sales permitted, no immediate on-site consumption.
Ergo/learning therapies	permitted
Bicycle trade and repair services	permitted
Family holiday resorts	closed
Holiday homes	the provision of services for tourist purposes is prohibited
Hairdressers	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements; prior appointment required
Pedicure	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements; prior appointment required
Gastronomy (establishments where food and/or beverages are offered for consumption on site)	permitted subject to compliance with the hygiene requirements (see "Handout for the catering industry - hygiene and safety measures for catering and accommodation", published on the MWVLW website)
Golf courses	permitted (in compliance with hygiene requirements and minimum spacing)
Church services	permitted in compliance with the hygiene requirements; passing on objects between the churchgoers among each other is not permitted (e.g. collection bags, hymn books, parts of a prayer rug etc.); communion and Holy Communion are for example permitted in compliance with the hygiene requirements
Church services in drive-in cinema format	permitted
Weddings	Civil marriages are permitted. Church weddings are also permitted subject to the regulations applicable to church services.
Hearing care professionals	permitted
Hotels	Operation for tourist purposes is prohibited.
Dog-walkers	permitted
Dog salons	permitted
Dog training schools	permitted
Canine sports	permitted
Snack stalls	permitted, no immediate on-site consumption
Training activities in mass and leisure sports outdoors	permitted in compliance with the prohibition of contact and minimum spacing; the emphasis is on the individual's own physical activity; leisure

	activities of a predominantly touristic character are not permitted
Youth hostels	closed
Kiosks	permitted
Pubs	permitted, in compliance with the hygiene requirements applicable to catering establishments (see " Handout for the catering industry - hygiene and safety measures for catering and accommodation", published on the MWVLW website)
Cosmetic studios	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements; prior appointment required
Agriculture	permitted
HGV wash facilities	permitted
Lottery registration office	permitted
Malls / outlet centres	permitted (in compliance with the regulations applicable to retail outlets); the obligation to wear a full-face mask exists within the entire mall/outlet centre regardless of whether it is a closed building complex or a delimited area in the open air.
Massage salons	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements; prior appointment required
Furniture collection services	permitted
Museums	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements
Music schools	permitted, provided that at least the "Hygiene Plan Corona for Schools in Rhineland-Palatinate" of 21 April 2020 (published on the Ministry of Education website) in its current valid version is complied with; singing lessons are not permitted.
Nail studios	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements; prior appointment required
Orthopaedic shoemakers, orthopaedic technicians	permitted
Parcel drop-off or collection points	permitted
Personal trainers	personal training 1 to 1, permitted in a single room in a fitness studio in compliance with the hygiene regulations, in a fitness studio otherwise closed for general sports and training operations
Pawnshops	permitted
Physiotherapy	permitted
Podology	permitted
Travel agents	permitted, in compliance with the rules applicable to retail trade outlets

Restaurants, eateries (and similar establishments where food and/or beverages are offered for consumption on site)	permitted, in compliance with the hygiene requirements applicable to catering establishments (see " Handout for the catering industry - hygiene and safety measures for catering and accommodation", published on the MWVLW website)
Sanitary supplies	permitted
Locksmiths	permitted
Ski lifts	closed
Shisha bars	closed
Solariums	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements
Marinas	permitted
Dance schools	closed
Tattoo studios	permitted subject to compliance with hygiene requirements; prior appointment required
Taxi services	permitted
Tennis (popular sport)	permitted outdoors
Retail trade outlets	permitted irrespective of the range of goods and the size of the establishment, in compliance with hygiene requirements. The size of the facility only influences the calculation of the permitted number of persons (e.g.: sales area of 800 sqm: max. 80 persons; sales area of 900 sqm: max. 85 persons (80 + 5)
Weekly markets / supply markets / mobile retail trade sales stands	permitted
