

Interpretation aid for the 4th Corona Control Ordinance  
Rhineland Palatinate of 17 April 2020

What?	How?
Collection and delivery services	permitted for all types of goods, including non-commercial. Collectors must accept the ordered goods at door or window. Entry to the premises by the collectors is not permitted.
Angler parks	permitted
Car dealerships	sale and repair permitted
Dive-in cinema	permitted (in compliance with the hygiene requirements, i.e. it is not permitted to get out of the car, no sales of drinks or food)
Car renting/car sharing	permitted
Carwash facilities	permitted
Bakers	permitted No on-site consumption is permitted.
Bars	closed
Funerals	funerals are permitted in close family circles
Concrete production works	permitted
Company canteens	closed, takeaway sales permitted but not immediate on-site consumption (with the exception of hospital canteens)
Florists	permitted (max. 800 m2 sales area)
Blood donation appointments	permitted
Cafés	closed, street sales are permitted
Campsites	The operation of campsites for tourist purposes is prohibited. This applies to short-term and long-term campers. The use of these facilities without overnight stays is also prohibited. Only the use of the campsite as the main place of residence is permitted.
Copy shops	permitted
Ice cream parlours	closed; collection, delivery and drop-off services are permitted. Street trading permitted.
Ergo/learning therapies	permitted
Family holiday resorts	closed
Holiday homes	the provision of services for tourist purposes is prohibited
Podology	permitted

Garden centres	permitted
Golf courses	permitted (in compliance with the hygiene requirements and minimum spacing)
Church services in drive-in cinema format	(in compliance with the hygiene requirements, i.e. getting out of the car is not permitted)
Weddings	civil marriages are permitted
Hearing care professionals	permitted
Hotels	operation for tourist purposes is prohibited.
Dog-walkers	permitted
Dog salons	permitted
Dog training schools	permitted
Snack stalls	permitted, no immediate on-site consumption
Youth hostels	closed
Kiosks (especially those selling drinks, snacks newspaper sales and receiving post offices)	permitted
Cosmetic studios	closed
Agriculture	permitted
HGV wash facilities	permitted
Lottery retailers (in combination with newspaper sales)	permitted due to newspaper sales (main focus of sales decisive)
Malls / outlet centres	permitted (subject to compliance with hygiene requirements, in particular minimum spacing, control of access, for example by means of access controls; these requirements apply irrespective of whether sales take place in an enclosed building complex or in the open air). Individual shops whose range of goods is not among the permissible exceptions may not provide more than 800 m <sup>2</sup> sales area.
Massage salons	closed. Medical massage permitted
Furniture collection services	permitted, since collection service
Music schools	closed
Nail studios	closed
Orthopaedic shoemakers, orthopaedic technicians	permitted
Parcel drop-off or collection points	analog to post offices, however no other sales
Personal trainers	permitted, but only at 1:1 tutoring
Pawnshops	permitted (provided that the sales area does not exceed 800 m <sup>2</sup> )
Physiotherapy	permitted
Travel agents	permitted (provided that the sales area does not exceed 800 m <sup>2</sup> )
Bicycle trade and repair services	permitted

Sanitary supplies	permitted
Locksmiths	permitted
Ski lifts	closed
Sunbeds	closed
Marinas	permitted
Dance schools	closed
Tattoo studios	closed
Taxi services	permitted
Tennis (popular sport)	permitted outdoors
Retail trade outlets	permitted irrespective of the range of goods, provided that the sales area on which goods are offered does not exceed 800 m <sup>2</sup> . In this case the total size of the store is not decisive but the sales area. Larger shops can therefore close off part of their floor area.
Weekly markets	permitted
